

Your Metrocard has its own unique card number which you can register online. Then you can not only check your balance, you can also top it up using your credit card. Start by calling Metroinfo on 03 366 88 55 to get your secure registration code. Then your online account is just a few clicks away.

## Manage your Metrocard balance online

You can use your Metrocard on all Metro services, including the Diamond Harbour Ferry. Tell the driver the destination you want to travel to, and place your Metrocard on the reader. It will deduct the fare and your new balance will display on the screen. When your balance is below \$5, the scanner displays a yellow light reminding you to top-up.

## Where to buy a Metrocard

Metrocards can be bought from the Bus Interchange in the city, Ara Institute, Northlands Shopping Centre, University of Canterbury and Lincoln University bookshops, Selwyn District Council offices and community libraries.

Just look for the 'The next bus due' section on the homepage at [metroinfo.co.nz](http://metroinfo.co.nz). If you're at your bus stop and you have a smartphone, just scan the QR code on the bus stop timetable panel to see the expected arrival time.

# Christchurch Hospital

## Getting to the hospital is easy by bus.

## Metro can help you get to Christchurch Hospital easily by taking the bus

Take the hassle out of trying to find a car park and take the bus. Approximately 600 Metro buses go directly past the hospital every day, picking up and dropping off passengers at bus stops located directly outside the hospital.

Additionally, approximately 1,000 buses per day go to the central city Bus Interchange, where you can get on a bus to the hospital, only a few minutes away from the Interchange. Take a look at the map (on reverse) to see the connecting bus routes. Another option is to leave your car near a bus stop convenient to you, and take the bus to the hospital.
