

Metrocard Design Competition Terms and Conditions

1. The competition is open to all ages.
2. Entries close at 5.00pm on 31st March 2019 and must be received before this time by being uploaded via the Metro website page at <http://metroinfo/promotions/Pages/Design-a-Metrocard.aspx>. All entrants must state their name, telephone number, and email address.
3. All entrants must download the artwork template from the website and design to the specifications stated on this template.
4. All entries must be received on this template and uploaded to the website in either jpg, pdf, or png file format only. Maximum file size is 25mb.
5. You may enter the competition as many times as you wish.
6. Judging will take place during the first week of April 2019. If there is a high number of quality entries it is the judges' discretion whether to short-list finalists for a final round of public judging via social media channels.
7. Competition prize winners will be notified as soon as possible following the judging process using the contact details provided. If not contactable you will subsequently forfeit the prize. Winning entries will be featured via Metro's marketing channels.
8. Competitors guarantee that the work they are submitting is their own, and has never been published, or broadcast, nor submitted to any other competition.
9. On entering this competition, prize winners irrevocably transfer copyright of their artwork to Environment Canterbury and each competitor agrees that Environment Canterbury may use their work in any of its publications, websites, social media accounts and/or in any promotional material and may amend or reformat the work however it chooses.
10. The competition is open to anyone who is a resident of Canterbury on 1st March 2019 except the judges and employees of Environment Canterbury, the organiser of the competition.
11. All information about how to enter the competition forms part of these terms and conditions. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final and by entering the competition, the competitor agrees to abide by these terms and conditions. The judges' decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
